NPI Provides Input Into Report

A northern Ontario think tank, based in Thunder Bay, is supporting a report from the Mowat Centre that outlines some of the policy gaps in the province.

The Northern Policy Institute helped to assemble the report by providing input from northern residents.

President Charles Cirtwill says it'll be used during the federal election to bring attention to its 33 recommendations.



He says the report largely identified issues that can be addressed in the north from the importance of achieving success in our Aboriginal communities to the lack of essential infrastructure and the difference in labour markets here.




