



North Policy Institute Prepares for 2015 Federal Election

THUNDER BAY – BUSINESS - Northern Policy Institute, along with The Mowat Centre and The Institute for Competitiveness and Prosperity are embarking on a project to create a Federal Economic Agenda for Ontario in the lead up to the expected federal election in 2015. The

project was introduced during the 2014 Ontario Economic Summit with the release of The Mowat Centre's discussion paper, *A Federal Economic Agenda for Ontario*.

According to the discussion paper, the purpose of the Federal Economic Agenda for Ontario is to: "define clearly the challenges and opportunities facing Ontario, develop a common vision and agenda on key economic issues, inform public dialogue, outline policy options that could be pursued by the federal government, and inform platform development by political parties in the lead up to the federal election."

The paper proposes five objectives that a federal policy agenda should support:

- Increased labour force participation
- Increased productivity
- Improved economic opportunity for all and reduced poverty
- Increased exports
- An improved federal fiscal framework that supports Ontario

Achieving these five goals will require the federal government to focus its attention on seven issues as identified in the discussion paper:

- Infrastructure
- Workforce development
- Immigration

The feedback, advice, and research that is collected in the coming months will be used to complete the Federal Economic Agenda for Ontario, with an intended release in the spring of 2015 in advance of the federal election.

"The challenges, opportunities, and options facing Ontario should be important to federal parties during the next year," the discussion paper reads. "The Ontario economy is facing global forces that are producing a once-in-a-century transformation in the provincial economy. Ontario's success will be crucial to the country's prosperity in the decades ahead."
